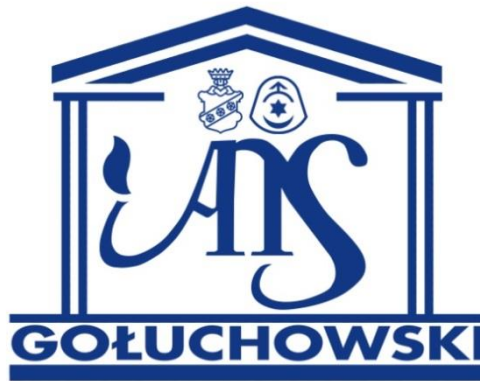

Purpose of study and organisational arrangements	<p>The aim of studies in the field of Social Work is the competent and specialized preparation of future social workers - having both specialized knowledge and practical skills. Studies in the field of social work include not only issues related strictly to social work, but also from the area of sciences directly related to the profession: sociology, pedagogy and psychology.</p> <p>Students gain pedagogical and educational competences that enable them to work in educational, cultural and social prevention institutions, as well as in governmental and non-governmental organizations.</p> <p>In order to properly organize the course of study, the subjects have been divided into modules: basic, field and specialty modules (to choose from).</p> <p>To make education more flexible and individualized, the study program provides for education at a spatial distance between the academic teacher and students (students), using distance learning methods and techniques and using electronic mass media (e-learning). Distance learning is carried out using dedicated computer software owned by the University or made available by a licensed service provider, using webcast technology. Distance learning takes place in accordance with the ANSG Distance Education Regulations.</p>

Profile of the graduate

The graduate of "Social Work" with a specialization in "Social Gerontology" is aware of the greatest challenges in the area of help and support for older people. He is well versed in contemporary demographic, economic and cultural trends, because of which he understands the specific problems of older people and is good at designing solutions intended for them. In addition, he knows the basics of andragogy, i.e. carrying out pedagogical tasks for adults and the elderly. Has knowledge and skills in animating free time, cultural and educational animation intended for older people. It is also familiar with the main aspects of health promotion and health education among specific age groups. Most importantly, he is proficient in designing and implementing specific assistance activities, which is facilitated by his knowledge of the senior support system, as well as practical knowledge of working with older people at various stages of the aging process and even dying. He is familiar with various social and legal factors in the care of the elderly, which makes him a versatile, potential employee of institutions focused on broadly understood assistance to seniors.

The graduate of the "Social Work" field, specializing in "Support for disabled people and their families", has extensive knowledge and skills in helping people with various types and degrees of disabilities. He has basic knowledge in the field of special pedagogy - obtained while completing the course modules, and during the path, he deepens his knowledge and competences in the field of assistance and support systems addressed in particular to disabled people. He also has extensive knowledge of the forms of professional activation of such people and work with them focused on this goal, which is one of the basic dimensions of social inclusion of these groups. The graduate has extensive information about the mechanisms of social exclusion of disabled people, and also has knowledge and competences in designing and providing them with various support. He is well versed in the psychology of disability and the basics of rehabilitation, as well as selected aspects of law, which makes him even more effective in the field of designing and implementing specific social strategies and projects. What is equally important, the graduate has information and competences that predispose him to effective cooperation with the immediate environment of a disabled person, who very often also requires specific support. This makes him a valuable candidate for a social worker dedicated to

	supporting disabled people and their loved ones.
Foreign languages used in lectures	The preferred foreign language, the mastery of which to the extent specified in the study program will enable the achievement of the expected learning outcomes, is English. This is related to the need for students to acquire English-speaking pedagogical terminology commonly used internationally, but also nationally, related to the studied specialization.
Student internships	Student internships are carried out in accordance with the Student Internship Regulations constituting an annex to the Order of the Rector of ANSG No. 13/2022 of October 1, 2022. amended by Order No. 4/2023 of the Rector of ANSG of February 15, 2023 and the Guidelines for student internships for the field of Social Work. The proper course of the internship is supervised by the internship supervisor, who, in addition to substantive supervision, helps students in organizing internships in institutions related to the studied specialty.
